In Homily, Chapter 6, St. John Chrysostom writes that the star did not lead the Magi to a palace or a grand place. Instead, it guided them to a simple home where the Saviour was staying. This shows us that God often uses simple

people, ordinary believers, to guide those who are searching for hope and salvation.

Our world today is dark and broken just as it was in the days of the Magi. Yet the Bible tells us, “The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it” from John chapter 1 verse 5. When we received Christ, His light entered our hearts and now we reflect Him wherever we go. Our thoughts, our daily work, our relationships at home, our connection with our neighbours, our compassion and our everyday living become small yet powerful lights just like that Christmas star shining in the night sky.

There may be moments when you feel insignificant, like a tiny speck in a huge universe. But the Christmas star reminds us that God does not look for size. He looks for clarity and a willing heart. Near you there is always someone who is wounded or confused or silently longing for a new life. God wants you to be that guiding light for them.

So shine. Shine with kindness, shine with truth and shine with the good news. Shine so that someone near you may find the brightest Light of all, the Lord Jesus Christ, the Light of the world. Wishing you and your family a blessed Christmas filled with His guiding light and joy.

With the theme There Is MORE, pastors, leaders, missionaries, and families came together for meaningful worship, powerful preaching, practical teaching, and a joyful celebration of God’s work in the region.

Participants represented many cultures, languages, and countries, reflecting the rich diversity of the Church of the Nazarene in Eurasia. The conference focused on six important ministry areas. These included engaging the next generation, developing leaders of Christian character, doing church and discipleship in the digital world, caring for immigrants and refugees, supporting creation and the vulnerable, and responding wisely to secularism.
